HANSEL AND GRETEL VS. THE WITCH

Based on the opera Hansel and Gretel
by Engelbert Humperdinck and Adelheid Wette
and The Original Folk and Fairytales of the Brothers Grimm

Music by Engelbert Humperdinck Libretto/Adaptation by Joshua Borths

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Scene 3 (Continued)

Gretel is forced to take the tray of sweets from the Witch and zoom over to the cage. As the Witch sings the aria with her broom, Gretel is forced to feed Hansel.

WITCH

I GIVE HIM SWEETS SO HE CAN EAT AND GROW INTO A TASTY TREAT.

AND ONCE I'M DONE WITH LITTLE HANS, THEN GRETEL JOINS MY WITCH'S DANCE.

WHEN WITH GRETEL I AM THROUGH, I'LL TURN MY ATTENTION ONTO YOU!

The Witch turns to the students and crosses out into the audience.

TOGETHER WE WILL MAKE A STEW, MY WORLD-FAMOUS "WITCH'S BREW!"

I'LL ADD A DASH OF BLACKENED CAT, AND DRAGON'S BLOOD, AND BIG-OL' BUGS!

WE WILL HAVE THE MOST-EST FUN!

The Witch interacts with the students. Hansel and Gretel take this opportunity to conspire.

Prrr.... IT'S BEGUN!

The Witch turns her attention back to Gretel. She snaps and Gretel is now free to move.

COME HERE, GRETEL.
ARE YOU FINISHED WITH HANSEL'S SWEETS?
HE WANTS MORE.
HE LOOKS HUNGRY!

GRETEL

Giving the Witch the now empty tray WE'RE OUT OF COOKIES.

The Witch puts down the broom to take the tray. While the Witch is distracted with her back turned, Gretel grabs the broom. As the following exchange happens, the Witch gathers up empty cooking equipment and stokes the fire.

HOCUS POCUS MAGIC SPELL!
FREE US NOW AND DON'T YOU TELL!

The spell works!

WITCH

Turning around WHAT DID YOU SAY LITTLE ONE?

Gretel puts the broom behind her back. She is now filled with confidence.

GRETEL

I SAID, WE WILL VANQUISH YOU TODAY!

WITCH

WHAT?!

GRETEL

Making up something that sounds better to the Witch. I'LL DO WHATEVER YOU SAY.

WITCH

Mollified, believing that she just misheard HA HA! THAT IS QUITE RIGHT. YOU GAVE ME SUCH A FRIGHT.

NOW GRETEL, COME TO ME. ALTHOUGH YOU'RE MINE, I STILL ASK NICELY.

Aside to the students I cannot wait to push her into the fire... mmmm...

Gretel moves towards the Witch and notices the now roaring fire.

HANSEL

To Gretel PLEASE, WATCH OUT! SHE'S ABOUT!

WITCH

Aside as she gathers up baking accoutrements I CANNOT WAIT FOR WHAT'S NEXT. WE HAVE REACHED OUR CLIMAX!

To Gretel, handing her cooking equipment NOW COME AND SEE

HOW TO BAKE MY SWEETS!

SINCE WE ARE OUT OF HIS TREAT-IES, YOU MAKE THE NEXT BATCH OF COOKIES.

FIRST, MAKE THE BATTER, THEN STIR IT FASTER. WHEN THAT IS DONE, OFF TO THE OVEN!

The Witch pushes Gretel towards the fire.

HANSEL

To Gretel PLEASE, WATCH OUT! SHE'S ABOUT!

GRETEL

To Hansel I KNOW WHAT TO DO! WAIT FOR MY CUE!

WITCH

To Gretel (not having heard the above exchange) COME ON AND HURRY. I'M GETTING HUNGRY!

Gesturing to the oven impatiently IT IS OPEN. NOW, GET THEM IN!

HANSEL

To Gretel PLEASE, WATCH OUT! DANGER'S ABOUT!

GRETEL

Overdoing her lie I HAVE A QUESTION ABOUT THE OVEN. SHOW ME ONCE AGAIN, HOW DO THE COOKIES GO IN?

WITCH

IT'S QUITE EASY.

JUST FOLLOW ME!

Happening in quick succession: The Witch impatiently shows Gretel how the oven works and how to put the cookies inside. While the Witch is distracted, Gretel again grabs the broom. She

releases Hansel from the cage with the broom's magic. The two then begin to chant the text below of the "Evening Prayer" as if they were a sports team getting ready for the big game.

HANSEL AND GRETEL

WHEN WE BOTH BEGIN TO STRAY, FAM'LY HELPS YOU FIND THE WAY!

They both push her into the oven. The Witch screams. Older Hansel appears on the other side of the stage and watches the action unfold.

HANSEL AND GRETEL

AND WITH ONE BIG HEAVE HO, DOWN THE WITCH GOES!

NOW THE WORLD IS TOTALLY WICKED-WITCH-FREE!

OLDER HANSEL

Cutting off the possible audience applause and music Stop! The actors freeze Everyone thinks that this is how the story ends, but it wasn't like that at all. The true story is far more magical. Let's rewind and see what really happened.

The actors "rewind" the staging back to the earlier point. NOTE: Have fun with this staging! Pianist improvises as the "rewind" occurs.

HANSEL

PLEASE, WATCH OUT! DANGER'S ABOUT!

GRETEL

I'VE A QUESTION
ABOUT THE OVEN.
SHOW ME AGAIN,
HOW DOES IT OPEN?

WITCH

IT'S QUITE EASY.

JUST FOLLOW ME!

HANSEL AND GRETEL

Chanted WHEN WE BOTH BEGIN TO STRAY, FAM'LY HELPS YOU FIND THE WAY!

Upon hearing them chant the text of the "Evening Prayer," the Witch suddenly turns around clearly in agony. The music stops. The following dialogue should stay high energy and over-thetop.

WITCH

Wait! I know that song! Where did you learn it?

GRETEL

Our parents taught it to us when we were little.

HANSEL

We've known it our whole lives.

WITCH

Memories flood back I used to know that song. My parents taught it to me when I was young.

GRETEL

You have parents?

WITCH

Had parents. I got lost in the woods and never saw them again. Getting mad I hated them for never finding me. How could they just give up like that!? So, I made it my life's work to make all children suffer as much as I did.

HANSEL

Well, maybe they did try to find you, or maybe you needed help finding them... Maybe all you needed to do was ask. Hey! You could ask us.

GRETEL

And if we follow the directions of the song, maybe your life could change.

HANSEL AND GRETEL

Preferrably a cappella FOR WHEN THE NIGHT IS DARKEST, DON'T FORGET WHERE YOUR HEART IS.

IT IS FOUND IN FAM'LY: EVERYTHING IN HARMONY.

SO, HAND-IN-HAND KEEP MARCHING ON. 'CAUSE SOON WE ALL WILL GREET THE DAWN.

WITCH

But, I'm an Evil Witch. How could I change?

GRETEL

By asking for help—

HANSEL

And using your powers for good!

GRETEL

Getting an idea You could use your magic to make all lost children found so that no one has to go through what you experienced.

HANSEL

And you could use your baking skills to help Tom Thumb feed everyone who's hungry.

GRETEL

You have so much to offer the world... You just have to try.

HANSEL

Theatrically And let others guide you to the light!

WITCH

No one's ever wanted to help me before. I only get what I want through fear... But... Well... Here it goes: Hansel and Gretel, can you help me find my parents and use my powers for good?

HANSEL AND GRETEL

Of course!

HANSEL AND GRETEL

HURRAY! I CAN'T BELIEVE MY EYES. THIS END IS A BIG SURPRISE.

HURRAY! THE WITCH HAS BECOME GOOD, FEEDING ALL THE CHILDREN IN THE WOOD!

MUSIC AND FAMILY WON THE DAY, AND SO WE SING!

NOW... LET THE WORLD KNOW WITCHES CAN ALSO GROW.

WE CAN CHANGE HEARTS AND MINDS WITH OUR SONGS AND RHYMES.

YES, HOW GRAND AND STRANGE

TO KNOW HOW THE WORLD CAN CHANGE!

The three of them celebrate as Father appears with Tom Thumb (still a puppet).
